

## PRODUCT INTRODUCTION CT/X® MS – MAXIMUM AIRFLOW

AS A LEADING EUROPEAN MANUFACTURER OF LARGE BOXES SPECIFICALLY FOR AGRICULTURAL APPLICATIONS, WE HAVE EXPANDED OUR PRODUCT RANGE AND IMPLEMENTED SEVERAL INNOVATIONS.

The application of RFID tags in standardised RFID nests or the application of RFID as in-mould labels is possible. Features of this new box include smooth side bars and rounded perforations on the inside, as well as a wide range of floor interface options (2 runner, 3 runner 4 feet). The development was carried out in cooperation with our headquarters JCO Plastic from Italy.

#### **Maximum Airflow reduces costs!**

Storing and cooling fruit in cold storage is a complex cost–intensive process, and our large boxes have been deliberately optimised for this purpose. With more perforated surface area, it is possible to achieve more air flow through the fruit and thus reduce the energy requirement for the cold store. This is done without compromising on stability. Good for our customers – good for the environment!







## MISSION ACCOMPLISHED

WE FINISHED A **MAJOR ORDER** FOR THE PRODUCTION OF VARIOUS WASTE COLLECTION CONTAINERS.

We received a major order for the production of various recyclable material collection containers from Croatia at the end of 2020. More than 250,000 pcs. Two-wheeled containers have since been produced around the clock, in part at 3 plants simultaneously, and continuously delivered to our partner in the south. The project has once again shown that Europlast is a reliable partner capable of handling large orders. Delivery logistics in particular played a major role, which functioned smoothly thanks to the customer's close coordination with our experienced logistics team. A big thank you to all those who have worked together to complete this tightly scheduled project on time.

At the beginning of April this year, our long-time colleague Silvia Lerchner took her well-deserved retirement. Among other things, she has made a significant contribution to building up sales in our company over the last 20 years and, in the end, was mainly responsible for Austrian customers and partners. Ms. Lerchner will continue to accompany us on a limited basis as we want to use her valuable know-how to develop a professional HR management system for a few more years.

After an intensive search, we were able to recruit Claudia Kogler (48) from Pörtschach a W. as her successor at the beginning of 2021. Ms. Kogler, who has already been a successful entrepreneur herself, was warmly welcomed into the team and will continue to ensure the warm and friendly care of our customers in the future!

For several years now, the storage and loading/unloading of injection moulds in our production hall has repeatedly presented our team with major logistical challenges. An extension has now made it possible to load and unload lorries by crane in a passage area in the hall. A tool store was created directly in front of the drive—through area where injection moulding tools can be stored. A new, self—developed test device for load tests of large boxes is also being installed in this area.

Furthermore, our injection moulding hall has been extended and a 1000t injection moulding machine is already being set up here, which will expand our capacity. Since our peak power demand is increasing as a result, we also need to expand the connection to the power grid by adding another transformer. In summer, an 800 kWp photovoltaic system will start operating on our roofs and supply  $\mathrm{CO}_2$ -neutral electricity. Our site therefore will continue to produce  $\mathrm{CO}_2$  neutrally.
